- Provide information on resource requirements to Project Management, Clinical Operations and other groups as required (e.g., clinical trial supplies, budgets, laboratory requirements).
- Responsible for implementation of integrated and comprehensive data-driven Quality Monitoring activities to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements and SOPs, and to ensure a continued state of inspection readiness.
- Create study synopses and protocols and support and provide input into the planning, design, preparation, initiation, and execution of study protocols and other required documentation in compliance with project plans, federal regulations, and GCP.
- Ensure clinical projects/programs are tracked and communicated to the executive team and appropriate functional groups in a consistent and timely manner.
- Help in the development and preparation of study manuscripts for intended publication.
- Represent the company in public forums (e.g., scientific conferences, advisory committees, and partnering discussions).
- Provide information to regulatory affairs as required. Manage the development of clinical trials and support/provide clinical site management during the course of clinical trials.
